The Company is advancing the IMA Mine Project in Idaho to commercial production, addressing critical metal scarcity in North America. The Company's IMA Mine Project is a historic and high-quality underground tungsten past-producing property on private-patented land well above the water table with significant infrastructure. The Company holds an exclusive option to acquire full ownership (subject to a 2% royalty) and has expanded its land position with 113 additional federal claims covering nearly 2,000 acres.

We found the January 20<sup>th</sup> news release titled, “*American Tungsten Reports Significant Tungsten in Underground Sampling*” particularly noteworthy and here are 5 key data points from it:

- **Underground High-Grade Vein Results** – American Tungsten Corp. reported channel samples from the IMA Mine averaging 1.04% W<sub>03</sub> and 2.70 oz/t Ag over 5 ft from the No. 5 vein, confirming strong grades within historic workings.
- **New Surface Targets Identified** – Rock-chip sampling discovered additional tungsten-silver quartz veins outside the main mine area, demonstrating mineralization extends beyond previously mined zones.
- **Historic Tailings Reprocessing Potential** – Preliminary test pits across a ~30-acre tailings impoundment averaged roughly 0.25% W<sub>03</sub> and ~0.45 oz/t Ag, suggesting a possible secondary resource opportunity.
- **Historical Data Validation** – The underground sampling program was designed to verify 1979 Inspiration Development data, and results support continuity of tungsten-silver mineralization across multiple vein phases.
- **Production Restart Strategy** – With drilling nearing completion, the Company is evaluating the project for a potential restart of underground mining at the past-

producing IMA Mine, which historically produced ~199,449 MTUs  $WO_3$ .
