Spartan Metals is focused on developing critical minerals projects in top-tier mining jurisdictions in the Western United States, with an emphasis on building a portfolio of diverse strategic defense minerals such as Tungsten, Rubidium, Antimony, Bismuth, and Arsenic. Spartan's flagship project is the Eagle Project in eastern Nevada that consists of the highest-grade historic tungsten resource in the USA (the past-producing Tungstania Mine) along with significant under-defined resources consisting of: high-grade rubidium; antimony; bismuth; indium; as well as precious and base metals.

We found the October 16th news release titled, “*Spartan Metals Commences Exploration Program at the Eagle Tungsten-Silver-Rubidium Project, Nevada*” particularly noteworthy and here are 5 key data points from it:

- **Exploration Program Launched:** Spartan Metals has initiated exploration at its Eagle Tungsten-Silver-Rubidium Project in Nevada, covering both Tungstania and Rees claim blocks. The work completes Phase 1 of the NI 43-101 program and starts Phase 2 surface geology activities.
- **Tailings Drilling Underway:** Drilling at the historic Tungstania millsite began on October 20, 2025, using a hollow stem auger to collect samples for geochemical and metallurgical analysis, 3D modeling, and resource estimation.
- **Comprehensive Surface Geology Work:** The surface program includes soil sampling on a 100 m × 100 m grid, rock and outcrop sampling, geologic mapping, and geophysical surveys (CSAMT/MT) to define W-Ag-Rb vein systems and refine drill targets.
- **High-Grade Historic District:** The Eagle Project spans 4,936 acres (244 BLM claims), hosting the past-producing Tungstania and Rees/Antelope mines, which yielded 8,379 units of tungsten (0.6–0.9% WO₃) from 1915–1956. Multiple porphyry, skarn, and CRD deposit types are present.
- **Strategic U.S. Critical Minerals Focus:** Under CEO and QP Brett R. Marsh, CPG, Spartan advances a U.S. critical-minerals portfolio centered on tungsten, rubidium, antimony, bismuth, and arsenic, supporting domestic and

defense-supply objectives.
