Homerun is a vertically integrated materials company pioneering advanced silica technologies to support the global energy transition. Positioned as a leader outside China in high-purity quartz (HPQ), Homerun manages the full value chain from raw silica extraction to solar, battery, and storage applications. Its **Advanced Materials** division is developing a 120,000 tpy processing plant to supply domestic and international markets and, in partnership with UC Davis, is advancing zero-waste thermoelectric purification and materials processing. Its **Energy Solutions** division is building Latin America's first 365,000 tpy solar glass facility, advancing perovskite photovoltaic technologies, marketing alternative energy in Europe, and commercializing AI-driven energy management systems. With U.S. DOE/NREL collaborations on long-duration storage, Homerun combines multiple profit centers, breakthrough IP, and ESG leadership to capture high-growth markets.

We found the September 16th news release titled, "*Homerun Resources Inc. Announces Updated Offtake Agreement with Brasil Fotovoltaico for the Supply of High-Quality Solar Glass*" particularly noteworthy and here are 5 key data points from it:

- **Updated Offtake Agreement** – Homerun signed a non-binding offtake agreement with Brasil Fotovoltaico Ltda. (BRFV) to supply 180,000 tonnes of solar glass annually from its Belmonte, Bahia facility, at an initial price of USD 750/tonne FOB.
- **Total Offtake Commitments** – With this agreement, Homerun now has 300,000 tonnes of solar glass offtake announced, with discussions underway that could increase total offtakes to 450,000 tonnes, exceeding the modeled 1,000 tonnes/day plant capacity.
- **BFS Progress** – The Bankable Feasibility Study (BFS) is advancing, with silica resources secured, plant engineering and cost models completed, infrastructure and utilities identified, and financing discussions ongoing, including with Brazil's development bank BNDES.
- **Market Context** – Brazil surpassed Germany to become the third-largest global solar module market, with rising

tariffs on imports encouraging domestic production and supporting vertically integrated local supply chains.

- **Strategic Positioning** – Homerun aims to become the leading domestic solar glass supplier in Brazil, reducing market risk through binding agreements post-BFS, while leveraging abundant silica resources and government-backed industrial expansion.
