- Follow-up MAG-TDEM Survey Planned Encouraged by the results, Quantum will undertake a high-resolution MAG-TDEM (time domain electromagnetic) survey to improve subsurface modeling and refine drill-ready targets for Ni-PGE exploration.
- Next-Generation Critical Metals Focus The NMX East work is part of Quantum's broader strategy to advance critical metals projects essential for next-generation technologies, including gallium, rubidium, cesium, antimony, germanium, and zinc.
- Strategic Québec Portfolio Alongside NMX East, Quantum is advancing several Québec-based projects (gallium-rubidium-cesium and polymetallic discoveries) plus new acquisitions in British Columbia, positioning the Company

as a diversified critical metals explorer in Canada.
