Appia is a publicly traded Canadian company focused on rare earth elements and uranium. The Company holds a 25% interest in Ultra Rare Earth Inc. ("Ultra USA"), which indirectly owns 100% of the Ultra Hard Rock and Ultra IAC projects in Goiás, Brazil, covering 42,932.24 hectares. Appia is also working to delineate high-grade critical rare earth elements and gallium at its Alces Lake property, while exploring for high-grade uranium in Saskatchewan's Athabasca Basin through its Otherside, Loranger, North Wollaston and Eastside properties. The Company holds surface exploration rights over 101,692.35 hectares in Saskatchewan and owns 100% of 14,483 hectares in Ontario's Elliot Lake Camp, where rare earth elements and uranium occur across five mineralized zones.

We found the August 6th news release titled, “*Appia Intersects REE-Bearing Monazite in Three of Six Drill Holes and Completes 2026 Alces Lake Summer Drill Program*” particularly noteworthy and here are 5 key data points from it:

- **2026 Summer Drill Program Completed** – Appia completed six diamond drill holes totaling 1,440.87 metres at its 100%-owned Alces Lake REE Property in northern Saskatchewan.
- **Monazite Found in Half the Holes** – REE-bearing monazite was visually identified in three of the six drill holes, including intervals in holes 26-ALF-001, 26-RSC-002 and 26-RSC-004.
- **Gravity Targets Confirmed at Depth** – Drilling confirmed several dense rock packages at depth that correlated with targets generated from the 2024 airborne gravity gradiometer survey and refined through the 2025 ground gravity survey.
- **274 Core Samples Submitted for Assay** – Appia collected and submitted 274 drill-core samples to the Saskatchewan Research Council for REE geochemical analysis, with results to be released after QA/QC review and

interpretation.

- **Follow-Up Target Pipeline Remains** – Three originally planned drill holes remain undrilled, and Appia has identified ten additional drill targets within the central regional corridor and fold structure for future drilling.
