

InvestorTalk Alert: Christopher Berlet from Stakeholder Gold Corp. to host on Tuesday, August 18, 2026, at 9:00 AM EST

Stakeholder holds 100% ownership of 1,140 contiguous mineral claims covering 22,700 hectares across 20 km of the Coffee Mine Project's Northern Access Route in Yukon's White Gold District, along with 10 additional claims inside the adjacent Coffee Mine Project being developed by Talamore Mining Corp. Together, these holdings form the Ballarat Gold-Copper Project. Within Ballarat, Stakeholder is advancing the Skye Gold Zone and Loki Copper Zone, two exploration targets located about 8 km apart on either side of the Northern Access Route and prospective for gold and copper discoveries. The Company also generates cash flow through its wholly owned Brazilian subsidiary, Mineração VMC Ltda., which produces exotic stone from four independent quarries and is pursuing expanded export sales.

We found the July 28th news release titled, “*Stakeholder Accelerates the Loki Copper Corridor: 3D Geophysical Inversions Nearing Completion Ahead of High-Impact 1,250-Sample Soil and Prospecting Programs Across Loki West and Newly Staked Loki East*” particularly noteworthy and here are 5 key data points from it:

- **Loki Is Moving From Data to Drill Targeting** – Stakeholder is completing 3D inversion modelling of historical VTEM data over the Loki Copper Zone and magnetic data over the Loki and Loki West targets to refine future copper drill targets.
- **The Targeting Work Is Focused Below Surface** – The 3D models are intended to identify conductive, potentially sulphide-related features and associated structures at depth along the Loki structural corridor.
- **1,250 Soil Samples Coming Next** – Stakeholder plans a large

soil geochemical program across Loki West and newly staked Loki East to define and expand copper-in-soil anomalies along the corridor.

- **Loki East Adds a New Area to the Program** – The newly staked Loki East target extends the Company's coverage southeast along the Loki structural corridor and will be evaluated for the first time.
- **Ballarat Sits on the Coffee Mine Access Route** – The Northern Access Route being built for the adjacent Coffee Gold Mine Project crosses Stakeholder's Ballarat property, adding 20 km of new mine-grade road access across its ground.
