He also served as Co-Founder and Non-Executive Chairman of Neo Lithium Corp. (TSXV: NLC | OTCQX: NTTHF | FSE: NE2), which advanced the world-class Tres Quebradas lithium project in Argentina before being acquired in a transaction valued at approximately US\$960 million. Throughout his career, Mr. Karayannopoulos has played a significant role in the development of the modern critical minerals industry and is recognized as one of the sector's foremost strategic thinkers and business leaders.
