

CVMR's Kamran M. Khozan to Headline CMI Summit IV with Keynote on Africa's Critical Minerals Opportunity

From securing critical mineral inputs for the U.S. Department of Defense to [launching](#) Albania's first environmentally neutral nickel refinery this spring, his track record underscores the commercial viability of localized, waste-free processing. “Africa's mineral wealth, harnessed responsibly, can redefine global supply chains,” Khozan states. “My keynote will outline how partnership-driven, near-zero-emission refining unlocks continental prosperity while delivering the critical minerals essential to an enduring, low-carbon future—creating value that resonates well beyond the mine

gate.”

On Tuesday afternoon, he will contribute to Panel 03, “Critical Minerals and the Impact of Trump Tariffs,” and on Wednesday, May 14 (3:15 – 3:30 PM ET) he will present “The American Critical Minerals Market,” detailing actionable strategies to repatriate advanced refining and magnet-metal production to U.S. soil.
